

### WHAT DO I NEED TO CONSIDER? "DO'S & DON'TS"

### DO'S:

**LEARNING AGREEMENT:** The selection of courses should resemble the courses selected in the Learning Agreement

#### **ECTS**

If possible, half of the courses should be selected from the major subject (see admission letter)

#### DON'T'S:

Courses offered by the School of Music, the Academy of Fine Arts and Medicine (except for non German courses) are unfortunately **not** open for exchange students from other subjects







### WHEN IS THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER?

- The deadlines for the registration are determined by the different departments
- There is no general registration deadline
- Ideally you should know which courses you want to attend at the beginning of the lecture period or at the end of the first week of the lecture period



### **COURSE REGISTRATION: EXCEPTION 1: LAW**

- → To register for Law courses you need a **special form**
- → You get it from the academic advisor for exchange students Mr. Klaus Mayer
- → For office hours and more information please see the **information sheet** of the *Auslandsbüro Jura*



### **COURSE REGISTRATION: EXCEPTION 2: ECONOMICS**

- → Course registration for Economic courses for students enrolled in Economics
- → online via JOGU-StINe
- → TAN list required (you already got it when you enrolled)
